

**K-12 Schools \$500 Grant Video Contest- Importance of IT Disaster Recovery

- K-12 School entrants must complete the contest entry form and provide valid contact information by Friday, March 2nd, 2012, at 11:59 p.m. Eastern Daylight Time. Submitting an entry form after this time will result in disqualification. On the entry form, ensure that you provide your unique video title. All forms and information can be obtained [here](#).
- Video entries must be submitted to the Indiana Data Center no later than Friday, April 27, 2012 at 11:59 p.m. Eastern Daylight Time. Videos received after this date will result in disqualification in this contest. Videos may be submitted on a disk that is mailed to the Indiana Data Center or by uploading your video file to a FTP site provided by the Indiana Data Center (FTP address and login will be provided proceeding your submission of the contest entry form).

- Entries will be judged by the Indiana Data Center Team and the winning video will be chosen based on the following criteria: use of creativity, strength and originality of content, and ability to highlight importance of protecting your data in the event of a disaster. In addition, technical accuracy; visual and audio quality will be taken into consideration. The Indiana Data Center reserves the right to not select a winner if none of the entries are deemed of sufficient quality based on the criteria.
- Your video must not infringe on any third party rights or contain any names, logos, or seals of any government agency, company, or organization other than the Indiana Data Center. You will be provided with the Indiana Data Center Logo for use in your video.
- Videos previously produced for compensation and/or copyrighted materials are not eligible and will be disqualified from this contest.
- The videos must not exceed 90 seconds in length. The video must be in .wmv, .avi, .mov, or .mpg file formats. Video must not exceed 500MB total size. Any video that does not meet these requirements will be disqualified from this contest.
- Contestants must direct viewers to the Indiana Data Center Web site by including the text www.inddc.com at some point during the video.
- Videos must include either the spoken or written phrase, **"Don't Gamble with Data Protection- Chose Indiana Data Center."**
- The winner of the \$500 grant and the candidates selected for honorable mention will be notified of their achievements by Mid-May, 2012.
- By submitting a video to this contest, you grant to the Indiana Data Center an irrevocable, royalty-free license to copy, distribute, modify, display and perform publicly, and otherwise use, as well as authorize others to use, your video for any purpose and in any media format.

- The Indiana Data Center is the sponsor of this contest. The Indiana Data Center reserves the right to make your video available to the general public from their Web sites and to distribute it to any other organizations interested in showing it for any purposes, including, but not limited to, on Internet sites, at conferences and events, on television, and other media outlets.
- The depiction of violence, profanity, or sex, or the inclusion of attacks on individuals or organizations, otherwise offensive material, or any other violation of the contest rules will result in the video's disqualification from this contest.
- You must be a U.S. citizen or legal resident to enter and win.
- Indiana Data Center employees and their immediate family members may enter, and may be recognized as the winner, but are ineligible for the monetary prize.
- The contest is void where prohibited or restricted by law. No purchase or payment of money is necessary to enter or win.
- The agreement of a legal parent and/or guardian must be obtained if the entrant is under the age of 18. Entrants will be required to submit our Permission for Minors form as well as the contest entry form.
